Nurses specifically trained by the PICC Team, like the ones in oncology and hematology units, who can instruct and correct their coworkers guarantee a better management of PICCs and Midlines and longer pre-occlusion time. These specifically trained nurses appear to be a good solution to improve the management of the devices.
