Identifying these patterns and arranging them in logical order can reduce dramatically the amount of time spent in the brute memorization of sounds unrelated to written forms. Many of the “primitive elements,” or building blocks, used in the drawing of the

characters also serve to indicate the “Chinese reading” that particular kanji use, chiefly in compound terms.
