Bar Exam (UBE) is a consistent measurement of minimum competency to serve as an officer of the court. But bar exam pass rates have been undergoing substantial declines as of late. Although the National Conference of Bar Examiners (NCBE) posits a variety of possible reasons for the declines, the NCBE provides empirical evidence for one claim, namely, that bar exam declines correspond with similar declines in Law School Admission Test (LSAT) scores by

Demographic disparities in bar exam pass rates are problematic but poorly understood. We investigate a possible explanation: participation in extracurricular activities, which could either distract from bar exam preparation or motivate and prepare students to succeed. Generally, participation in extracurricular activities while in law school does not play a large role in bar

exam success. However, there is a significant, arguably causal, penalty associated with one particular activity - pro bono work - most notably in lower-ranked law schools. This penalty is sizable: pro bono work is associated with a 5 percentage point (6%) decrease in the chances of passing the bar exam on the first attempt. This penalty is largest for Black and female students and may explain as much as 20% of the Black-white gap in first-attempt bar pass rates.
