This volume of LNICST is a collection of the papers of the 4th International Conference on Bio-Inspired Models of Network, Information, and Computing Systems (Bionetics). The event took place in the medieval city of Avignon, known also as the City of the Popes, during December 9 to 11, 2009. Bionetics main objective is to bring bio-inspired paradigms into computer engineering and networking, and to enhance the fruitful interactions between these fields and biology. The program of the conference indeed includes applications of various paradigms that have their origin in biology: population dynamics, branching processes, and evolutionary optimization. The proceedings include 19 papers covering a broad range of important issues in areas related to bio-inspired technologies. They correspond to presentations at 6 technical sessions. Four papers correspond to an invited

session on the Epidemic-type forwarding in DTNs (sparse mobile ad-hoc wireless networks) organized by Dr Francesco De Pellegrini, (Italy, CREATE-NET). The following 9 papers (selected out of 15 submissions) correspond to contributions to regular sessions on Bio-inspired security, Bio-Inspired Networking, Bioinspired algorithms and software systems. The remaining 6 papers (selected out of a total of 9 submissions) are dedicated to work in progress. For each paper, we have provided at least two independent reviews, most of which were offered by members of the TPC.
