These cognates can also be used to develop a Chinese-character-based transliteration for German and other European languages. If virtually every language can be written using a script based on Roman letters, why would the same not be possible with Chinese characters? Better yet, as opposed to the Latin script, Chinese characters not only represent a sound, but contain a meaning and show the etymology of the word as well. Cognates are expressed with the same character and words of a word group mostly share the same phonetic parts (glyphs). The meaning is contained in the radicals of Chinese characters. Creating a script based on Sinographs (characters consisting of Chinese radicals and phonetic parts) for Western languages will make language learning considerably easier. Cognates will simply be recognized instead of being searched for in etymological dictionaries. It may well promote the learning and understanding of other languages at first sight.
