Subjective questions on welfare, such as satisfaction with particular welfare dimensions, are increasingly being used to measure changes in well-being during crises. Although subjective questions on welfare have well-known limitations, it is possible that analyzing changes in response to large events can address some of these concerns. However, this paper illustrates a new difficulty in interpreting changes in such measures in tumultuous circumstances. Specifically, crises can impact both the scale with which households report their subjective assessments and the behaviors from which deprivations are traditionally inferred, and it is unclear how well subjective measures align with traditional welfare metrics in such a setting. This paper demonstrates the importance of this issue following the onset of the conflict in the Republic of Yemen, which caused large declines in nearly all traditional measures of well-being. However, the findings show that households reported a large increase in satisfaction in the same welfare dimensions where deprivations increased.

Question answering (QA) aims to develop techniques that can answer many varieties of questions, from simple Factoids to complex subjective questions. The goal of QA is to find the best answer to a question, given the available data related to the question topic. The biggest problem for QA is to find appropriate answers to subjective questions, such as "Is belief A better than belief B?" It has been noted that "A number of question answering systems have been developed which are capable of carrying out the processing required to achieve high levels of accuracy. However, little work has been reported on techniques for quickly finding exact answers." (Greenwood, 2005). The objective of this thesis is to understand the best way to find the best answer for subjective questions posed through online search, and put this process on the path to automation. This thesis investigates a

number of techniques for performing QA, and suggests an overall process for conducting QA operations. This process consists of a number of phases, including: (1) Select Question, (2) Select Search Engine, (3) Execute Query, (4) Search Selected Websites for Evidence, (5) Process Evidence, and (6) Deliver Final Answer. Four questions were identified to test the suggested method: (1) "Should the federal government have bailed out companies like AIG in the financial crisis of 2008 - 2009?" (2) "Is solar energy better than wind energy as an alternative energy source?" (3) "Are arranged marriages happier than marriages for love?", and (4) "Is faster-than-light travel possible?" These questions were searched using Google, and a list of websites was returned. Some of these websites could contain evidence pertinent to answering the questions, and some would not. The list of websites returned was generally very large, which made searching all of them infeasible. Thus, a set of websites to search had to be extracted from the original list. Once determined, the websites in this set were searched for evidence relating to the question. Some of the evidence discovered could be pointing to a "yes" answer to the question, some could be pointing to a "no" answer, and some could be neutral, not really indicating one way or another. Thus, any conflicting evidence had to be reconciled before a final answer to the question could be given. Once this was done, a final answer of "yes", "no", or "neutral" was returned, along with an indicator of how strongly the particular answer returned was favored. Using this process, the final answers returned were "yes" for questions one and three, "no" for question two, and "neutral" for question four. These results demonstrated the feasibility of the suggested process, and paved the way for automation of that process.
