•Gen. David Petraeus, a driven soldier-scholar. Determined to reach the Army's summit almost since the day he entered West Point, he sometimes

alienated peers with his ambition and competitiveness. When he finally got his chance in Iraq, he—more than anyone—changed the Army's conception of what was possible. Masterfully written and richly reported, *The Fourth Star* ranges far beyond today's battlefields, evoking the Army's tumultuous history since Vietnam through these four captivating lives and ultimately revealing a fascinating irony: In an institution that prizes obedience, the most effective warriors
