Simpson's book *As We Have Always Done* argued for the central place of storytelling in imagining radical futures. *Noopiming* (Anishinaabemowin for "in the bush") enacts these ideas. The novel's

characters emerge from deep within Abinhinaabeg thought to commune beyond an unnatural urban-settler world littered with SpongeBob Band-Aids, Ziploc baggies, and Fjällräven Kånken backpacks. A bold literary act of decolonization and resistance, Noopiming offers a breaking open of the self to a world alive with people, animals, ancestors, and spirits—and the daily work of healing.
