ability to practice in this role without any formalized training may be one of the reasons nurse practitioners are less recognizable in this area as are other surgical assistants (physician's assistants, registered nurse first assistants, certified first assistants). This thesis discusses the importance of the role of the first assistant to the surgical process. The author proposes the establishment of a one year

fellowship for Acute Care Nurse Practitioners in first assisting and granting them the title and scope of practice of the Certified Surgical Nurse Practitioner. A questionnaire utilizing a Likert scale one year after graduation from the program will serve to answer the research question, "Would the new role of the Certified Surgical Nurse Practitioner benefit surgical services?" The

program is based upon first assisting education models recommended by the Association of Operating Room Nurses. Through the literature review the author concludes that establishment of this program and new role would benefit surgical services. Recommendations and implications for nursing are for adoption of this model into practice by nursing schools and recognition by

credentialing agencies of the role of the Certified Surgical Nurse Practitioner. The author also strongly encourages other advanced practice nurses to look for areas where similar fellowship programs can be established.
