This thesis analyzes the strengths and weaknesses of the SwissID launched in 2017 concerning its implementation in the Swiss market. Based on a framework incorporating legal, organizational, technological, political, and path dependency aspects as well as the analysis of the case studies of Estonia and Sweden, the major opportunities and risks for the future of the SwissID are identified. On one hand, the results show that the virtual monopoly which was created by the consortium of 19 companies in the market-driven e-ID environment can enable a standardized and user-friendly solution. The economic and political environment are positive for the implementation of the SwissID and the two-sided market can be served on the supplier side by the members of the consortium acting as solution providers of the SwissID. On the other hand, the legal situation is still unclear, and part of the society is concerned about the organizational set-up with no government involvement since identity provision is often still seen as a purely public issue.

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
