This section reports on the organisation, procedures, and publications of the ICMI Study, The Future of the Teaching and Learning of Algebra. Key words: Study Conference, organisation, procedures, publications The International Commission on Mathematical Instruction (ICMI) has, since the 1980s, conducted a series of studies into topics of particular significance to the theory and practice of contemporary mathematics education. Each ICMI Study involves an international seminar, the "Study Conference", and culminates in a published volume intended to promote and assist discussion and action at the international, national, regional, and institutional levels. The ICMI Study running from 2000 to 2004 was on The Future of the Teaching and Learning of Algebra, and its Study Conference was held at The University of Melbourne, Australia from December to 2001. It was the first study held in the Southern Hemisphere. There are several reasons why the future of the teaching and learning of algebra was a timely focus at the beginning of the twenty first century.
