The GAO & the Pres. Council on Integrity & Efficiency (PCIE) maintain the Financial Audit Manual (FAM). The FAM provides guidance for performing financial statement audits of Federal entities & is a key tool for enhancing accountability over taxpayer-provided resources. In Oct. 2003, the Checklist for Reports Prepared under the CFO Act was revised, & comments were requested on an exposure draft of the checklist. One of the key changes in the final checklist is its title, which has been changed to Checklist for Federal Accounting, Reporting, & Disclosures to reflect the checklist's potential application to any Federal entity preparing annual audited financial statements in accordance with the OMB's form & content guidance.

Section 3512 (c) and (d) of Title 31 of the United States Code (commonly known as the Federal Managers' Financial Integrity Act (FMFIA)) requires the Comptroller General to issue standards for internal control in the federal government.
