Missouri deserves credit for being one of two states that meets the goal of having teachers wait five years for tenure, and this policy serves as a best practice model for other states. The state, however, should ensure that new teachers know the science of reading instruction, strengthen its alternate routes to certification and ensure that special education teacher candidates receive the training they need to become highly qualified. The body of the

**A Data Comparison of the Impact of Nationally Board Certified Teachers on Student Achievement**

Given that there has been a recent movement toward alternative certification of teachers in all fields, and particular to

this study, in business and marketing education, this study of traditional (TR) and alternative routes to certification (AC) sought to discover characteristics and experiences of business and marketing education teachers in Missouri in regard to their preparation for certification to teach. This study used quantitative methodology and gathered data from an electronic survey sent to Missouri business and marketing education teachers who were granted initial certification

to teach during 2001 to 2008 and for whom email addresses could be located. The data was analyzed for percentage relationships cross-tabulated by route to certification. The study findings discovered that there is no shortage of business and marketing teachers in Missouri, though it is possible that alternative certification practices may help create a more diverse population of teachers and may serve more hard-to-serve school districts. The AC teachers do not rate

themselves as competent in content or pedagogy as highly as did the TR teachers. Both AC and TR teachers credit their work experiences and professional education courses as most influential in their success, along with their age and maturity. The implications of the research are related to developing appropriate teacher preparation policies and practices, defining the role of secondary teacher preparation programs, and improving the overall

quality of teacher preparation with appropriate training that incorporates real-world experiences, and considers the age/maturity influence for success in teaching.

### **School Money Trials**

The purpose of this study was to determine the teaching readiness of beginning Adult Basic Education (ABE) teachers as perceived by ABE administrators and teachers and to determine to what degree beginning teachers perceived their teaching readiness to be

the result of Missouri's ABE Beginning Teacher Workshop. Beginning Adult Basic Education teachers, for purposes of this study, were individuals who had met the Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education minimum requirements of a bachelor's degree and attendance at an ABE Beginning Teacher Workshop and who were in their first year of teaching Adult Basic Education. At the time of this research, Missouri was one of only eleven



states that required specific training for Adult Basic Education teachers. Fourteen states required ABE teachers to hold elementary or secondary certifications, and twenty-five states had no certification requirements at all. A review of the literature revealed twenty competencies cited most often and believed to be most important for Adult Basic Education teachers. The performance of those critical competencies were judged by the teachers themselves and the administrators who

observed and evaluated teachers as they worked with the wide array of students who typically make up an Adult Basic Education class. The results indicated that neither an education degree nor previous teaching experience contributed significantly to teachers' perceptions of teaching readiness in Adult Basic Education. An education degree and previous teaching experience did contribute significantly to the combined score indicating teachers' perceptions of
